About the Emmett Technique

The **Emmett Technique** uses a combination of direct pressure and gentle switches to release specific muscle groups and allow the client's body to return to a state of balance. The results are often dramatic, and can be instantaneous, with most clients recognising the improvements in pain levels and range of movement before leaving the clinic. Practitioners are trained in assessment skills and how to use the best combination of moves in their knowledge base to effect change. Additionally, practitioners are taught special language skills in order to assist the client to recognise and enhance the changes so achieved and this adds to the successful outcome of the work. The Emmett Technique works well alongside any bodywork therapy and greatly enhances the practice of any therapist.

There are 6 modules, taught over 5 two-day workshops, plus a one-day review of Mod 6. Modules 1 & 2 are one day each and taught as a 2 day workshop. Subsequent modules are two days each and include a review of the work from previous modules.

Venue Details - Douai Abbey, Upper Woolhampton, Reading

Douai Abbey is a Benedictine monastery, and has been welcoming quests as a long tradition. The buildings are an eclectic mix of old and new, and are situated amongst lovely peaceful grounds.

The accommodation is simple, clean, comfortable and quiet – perfect to ensure a good night's sleep after a full day of Emmett training. Each room has a hand basin and shower or bath with shared toilet facilities very close by, while some have full en-suite facilities. Guests have access to a common room and library and are welcome to bring their own wine etc into the establishment (as the Abbey doesn't have a liquor licence). This is a place of peace, and as such there are no televisions or phones in the rooms - which can often be welcomed as a nice change for a few days. A quest computer is available to access emails.

Those of us staying for lunch will dine together in the guest refectory, and special dietary requirements can be accommodated – give this information to Christopher when booking your accommodation.

Guests can come and go from the Abbey as they please, so you are welcome to go out for dinner at local restaurants and pubs for a change of scenery (just simply let Br Christopher know in advance so food isn't wasted). The driveway gates are closed at 8pm.

Douai Abbey is **easy to find**, signposted off the A4, in between Newbury and Reading. Visit www.douaiabbey.org.uk for the location map and directions.

The **food is delicious!** There is no obligation to stay at the Abbey.

Full Board: £65.00 per night (bed and all food) Payment due on final day of stay.
